



Training of Umpires for ACCSO Competitions E-learning Course of Study

GETTING STARTED GUIDE



The ACCSO committee have compiled an e-learning course of study with four components for those who agree to be trained to umpire in ACCSO competition matches.

The core of the course is ECB ACO It's Your Call Umpire Education - Stage 1 which strongly recommends also following MCC Laws ELEARNING .

The above are supplemented by a separate presentation from ACCSO on the local regulations and expectations of umpires, followed by a test for the student to see how well they have taken on board the topics presented.

Technical Requirements



MS Windows: view using Chrome (recommended) or Firefox (tested) as the browser which needs to also run Flash Player, and have any ad-blocker software disabled.

MacOS, iOS, iPad: view using Google Chrome (recommended) or Firefox (not tested) as the browser

Some students whose native language is not English may find it useful to have the French translation of the Laws open in another window. <https://www.lords.org/mcc/about-the-laws-of-cricket>

Students should follow through the components in the following sequence;

1. **ECB ACO - It's Your Call Umpire Education Stage 1 including MCC - Laws Elearning component** from <http://booking.ecb.co.uk/d/qnqtjd>

If you have not already registered on the ECB courses this can be done from the home screen as follows;



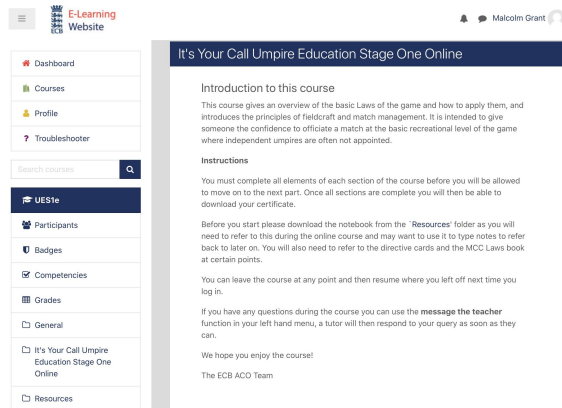
A. Register by clicking on 1, in the Quantity box and Register



B. Enter your details in the form

Your password will be sent to your email address within 2 working days'. Log in as step A above but click on Already Registered to arrive at page UES 1.

Follow the course through by logging in with your email and password from the Already Registered link above.

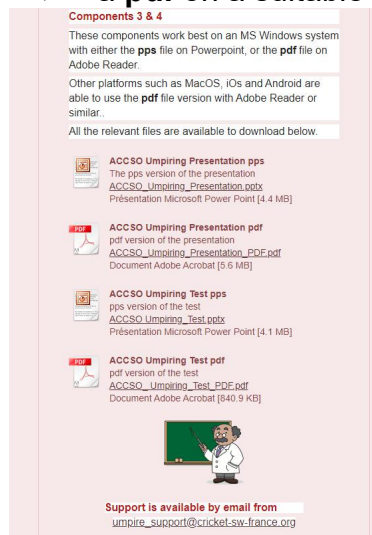

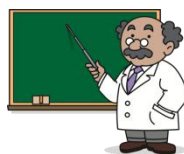
