Supplementary Regulation Net Run Rate (NRR)

- 1. NRR (Net Run Rate) will be used as and where ACCSO Committee decides that a mechanism is needed to separate teams in the following circumstances:
 - In a League format, where two or more teams finish the season with the same number of points;
 - ➤ In a knock-out format, where a match ends with the 2 teams having scored the same number of runs;
 - ➤ In a T20 competition, where the day ends with all the participating teams having won the same number of matches. Applies both to a situation where 2 teams play each other twice on the same day, including in a 3-team round-robin situation;
 - Where a match cannot be completed on the scheduled day and with no possibility of a replay/postponement.
- 2. Application: The regulations for each competition will specify whether NRR applies.
- 3. The NRR of each team is calculated as follows:

(runs scored #) () minus (overs faced #)	(runs conceded #) () (overs bowled #)
# Total of runs/ overs in all (1 to n)	of the matches concerned.
