Supplementary Regulation - Net Run Rate (NRR)

Version 20250301

1. **NRR (Net Run Rate)** will be used as and where ACCSO Committee decides that a mechanism is needed to separate teams in the following circumstances:
 - a) In a League format, where two or more teams finish the season with the same number of points;
 - b) In a knock-out format, where a match ends with the 2 teams having scored the same number of runs;
 - c) In a T20 competition, where the day ends with all the participating teams having won the same number of matches. Applies both to a situation where 2 teams play each other twice on the same day, including in a 3-team round-robin situation;
 - d) Where a match cannot be completed on the scheduled day and with no possibility of a replay/postponement.
 - e) **In all matches, if a team is bowled out inside their allotted overs, their run-rate is calculated by dividing the runs scored by the maximum number of overs which they could have received in that match. See ¶ below.**
2. **Application:** The regulations for each competition will specify whether NRR applies.
3. **The NRR of each team is calculated as follows:**

$$\frac{(\text{ runs scored } \#)}{(\text{ overs received } \text{¶})} \quad \text{minus} \quad \frac{(\text{ runs conceded } \#)}{(\text{ overs bowled } \#)}$$

Total of runs/ overs in all (1 to n) of the matches concerned.

¶ Overs received or allotted (see 1.a), above.
