

ACCSO 2025 Secretary & Competitions Report

Yet another season has come to a successful completion.

As per many of the previous 32 years of ACCSO competitions, all sorts of variables tested all of us in trying to complete the scheduled matches. There were the usual culprits of rainstorms followed by heatwaves, this year seemed particularly difficult with these events always seeming to fall on weekends. As if the weather this year wasn't enough to test us, other difficulties were felt in Occitanie with a ground invasion rendering Toulouse unusable and Nimes encountering difficulties in getting their pitch delivered. Despite all of this we did manage to get all the fixtures rescheduled, thanks in part to the reserve days (all bar one were used) but especially to those captains (and club management in certain cases) that communicated properly between themselves and kept us informed so that cricket could continue. It is rather unfortunate that despite managing to reschedule all matches, 5 matches were forfeited. A good team effort by the clubs as well as the 127 Licensed players that partook in the 2025 competition season allowed to have a result in all three ACCSO competition formats with a total of 33 (out of the 38 scheduled Matches being played).

In the Occitanie region, the Toulouse Bears came out strong from the start of the season and headed straight to the top of the table, 2024 title holders Catus struggled to get going and were quickly out of contention. The Toulouse Wolves made a valiant effort to catch up to the Bears on points but couldn't quite achieve a

superior net run rate thereby making the Toulouse Bears as winners of the Occitanie ligue and heading through to the final. In Nouvelle Aquitaine the Ligue could not have been tighter with all three teams coming out even on points after their allotted 6 matches. It was through their superior net run rate that Eymet managed to squeeze out Eyliac and Damazan to become the nouvelle aquitaine Ligue winners. In the grand final held in Damazan 3 weeks after the expected end of season, it was Eymet that came out on top and took home the trophy of ACCSO Blevins Franks Ligue Champions 2025.

Catus and Toulouse Bears came out of the Quarter Finals having beaten Eyliac and Damazan. The Toulouse Bears continued their form by getting past 2024 title holder Eymet in the Semi-Final. 2024 Finalists Catus fell short at the semi-final with Toulouse Wolves making it through and thereby ensuring an all TCC affair at the


sponsors flagship event at Catus. At the grand final it was the Toulouse Wolves that managed to overcome their clubmates and become the ACCSO Blevins Franks Cup Champions 2025.



In the ACCSO T20. Things could not have been any tighter in the T20 tournament. All 7 entrants to the competition completed their first round of matches with one win and one loss leading all three groups (Nouvelle Aquitaine super league and 2 * Occitanie quarter finals) to be split by Net Run Rate. Nimes and Toulouse Bears being the 2 Occitanie teams heading through to the Occitanie semi finals while Eymet, after

having to wait a few days for the match reports to be submitted and the nr's to be crunched and verified, managed to edge out Eyliac and Damazan to head through to the finals. Toulouse Bears booked their spot in the final by beating the 2024 title holders Nimes in the Occitanie Semi-final. A tight fought single match grand final which went right down to the last few overs saw Eymet take the title of ACCSO T20 Champions 2025.

A big thank you to all involved for teaming together and making cricket in the south west of France work!






