Results of the two ACCSO Indoor tournaments held on Sunday 8th March 2009, at St Astier (24) and at Lisle-sur-Tarn (81).

In the absence of a national competition this year, these tournaments were billed as friendlies and they were, according to all reports, played as such.

At St Astier, St Aulaye were the winners, with Catus runners-up and Eymet third.

The St Aulaye team included three juniors – and two others played for Eymet. In the game against Bordeaux, St Aulaye junior all-rounder Daniel Nott took 3-6 in 9 balls.

Top scorer on the day was the St Aulaye skipper, Adrian Raynor: 71 in two innings (48 and 23 both not out). For Eymet Ian Hull scored 47 not out against St Aulaye; and David Horlock scored 69 in his three innings. For Catus John Paul Patraj scored 57 in his three.
